INVOKING THE HIGHER LAW

A wise man said that each nation gets the government it deserves. If this is the case, the Israelis should not complain about the Sharon government. If this is not the case, and the Israeli people were tricked into electing a government that does not reflect their wishes, they should do something about it.

Even if a government has used democratic processes to subvert the will of the people, its citizens are entitled to use any means that work to rid themselves of that government. The time for listening to anyone's excuses has passed, the time for action is now.

ISRAELI GOVERNMENT ACTION SUPPORTS CONSPIRACY THEORY

There is a conspiracy theory that goes with every major political assassination. It was true of Lincoln, President Kennedy, Senator Kennedy and Martin Luther King, Diem of South Viet Nam and Allende of Chile. There also is a conspiracy theory that is attached to the death of Yitzchak Rabin. While there is the usual official denial that Rabin's death involved a great deal more than what we learned from the media, certain actions by the Israeli Government continue to stoke speculation that the official story is not glat kosher.

Based on my review of news sources relating to Rabin's shooting and its aftermath, I came up with a theory that Rabin was not killed by the accused shooter but killed sometime later by leftwing elements associated with the government. I sent my bit of Sherlock Holmesing to a journalist in Israel for his comments. He wrote back asking if I was familiar with Barry Chamish's work. I had never heard of him.

Several month's later, a friend returning from Israel brought the book by Barry Chamish, titled: WHO MURDERED YITZCHAK RABIN? This volume fill in the details of the theory that I came up with on my own. To me, it is a convincing expose of the Shabak (Israel's security services agency) conspiracy behind the assassination of Rabin. The author has collected an overwhelming array of evidence that the left wing bodyguards, police, judges and government officials conspired to murder Rabin and to cover up the facts by threatening anyone including the doctors that tried to save him.

Somewhere along the line, a plan for an "attempted assassination" aimed at blackening the reputation of the right wing and those opposed to the "peace process" was turned into a murder on orders from someone high in the government, perhaps with the backing of the American Government. Sounds crazy? Don't forget that Kennedy gave the OK for the murder of Diem, the leader of America's ally South Viet Nam, and the assassination attempts against Castro. And which U.S. president OK'd the murder of Allende.

Of course there was an "official" investigation and trial, which did not deal seriously with the unofficial information concerning Rabin's assassination. The purpose of these investigation commissions, everywhere, is not to arrive at any truths which may become disruptive to the smooth operation of the State, but to put the assassination "behind us" and to get on with business as usual.

There was an agent provocateur working for Shabak who faked events for the media designed to hurt the right wing. He also kept encouraging the shooter, Yigal Amir to kill Rabin and even supplied him with the weapon. After a great deal of pressure from the right, this agent, Avishai Raviv was finally indicted for some of his activities. But every time Raviv's case is supposed to come to trial, the Israeli government finds a reason for delaying it. This has been going on for years. The most recent instance was just a week ago. What is the government afraid of? Can we expect that Raviv will become the victim of a fatal accident before

he ever gets to trial?

While Raviv's trial is regularly delayed, a young woman friend of Amir's sits in an Israeli prison convicted of not reporting that Amir said that he wanted to kill the Prime Minister. She claimed that she never believed his rantings--a claim which would have absolved her in any other justice-oriented court system. She is in jail while the government agent who encouraged the shooting, and knew that it was going to happen, walks around free.

By the way, the technique of using a political assassination to blacken the reputation of an opposition movement works, at least in the short run. It also is not new for Israel's left wing. Over 60 years ago in Tel Aviv, a leading left wing union leader was shot to death. The right wing Revisionist movement was blamed for the murder. Some 50 years after the event, several of the participants admitted that it was a left wing conspiracy.
